### CATEGORY FU - FULL

Subscription £356                      Entry Fee £356                      (Boat owner's Entry Fee £178)  
Full Members are those persons residing permanently in Northern Ireland who have attained the age of 24 years.

### CATEGORY FS - FULL MEMBER & SPOUSE

Subscription £534                      Entry Fee £534                      (Boat owner's Entry Fee £267)  
Full Members and Spouses are persons residing permanently in Northern Ireland who have attained the age of 24 years and are married.

### CATEGORY RE - OVER 65

Subscription £178  
Members who have attained the age of 65 years during the year prior to their next subscription falling due.

### CATEGORY RS - OVER 65 MEMBER & SPOUSE

Subscription £267  
Members who have attained the age of 65 years during the year prior to their next subscription falling due.

### CATEGORY WI - WIDOW/WIDOWER

Subscription £178  
Widow/widower of deceased Member.

### CATEGORY HS, HLS, LS - SPOUSES OF CATEGORIES HO, HL, L

### CATEGORY JR - JUNIOR

Subscription £89                      Entry Fee nil  
Junior Members are those persons residing permanently in Northern Ireland who have attained the age of 18 years but are under the age of 24 years.

### CATEGORY ST - STUDENT

Subscription £35                      Entry Fee nil  
Student Members are those persons domiciled in Northern Ireland in bone fide full-time education.

### CATEGORY CA - CADET

Subscription £35                      Entry Fee nil  
Cadet members are those persons over the age of 10 years but under the age of 18 years.

### SUB-CATEGORY JC – JUNIOR CADET

Subscription £35                      Entry Fee nil  
Junior Cadets members are those persons over the age of 8 years but under the age of 10 years whose parents are prepared to accept the restrictive nature of this sub-category of membership for their child, the conditions of which may be varied by the Committee at any time as it considers appropriate. (See conditions opposite).

### CATEGORY OU - OUTPORT

Subscription £35                      Entry Fee nil  
Outport Members are those persons residing outside Northern Ireland or such Members of H.M. Forces and others as the Committee may decide be elected outboard members.

The Committee has resolved that under the provisions of Rule 22, new members joining and bringing a new boat or purchasing an existing boat to sail at RNIYC should, for the time being, pay a lesser entry fee as above in brackets.

**NEW MEMBERS CAN ONLY JOIN IN CATEGORIES CADET, OUTPORT, JUNIOR, STUDENT, FULL OR FULL & SPOUSE. CONCESSIONARY RATES ARE ONLY AVAILABLE TO THOSE WHO HAVE BEEN FULL MEMBERS FOR TEN OR MORE YEARS.**

### Junior Cadet Membership Category

The conditions decided upon by the Committee are:

1. Age entry level 8 -10.
2. Parent must be a member.
3. Purpose of membership, to specifically encourage sailing for 8-10 year olds as helms, crew and on sailing courses.
4. Entitled to use all club facilities; take part in all appropriate training sessions; club racing; use of cadet room etc
5. Membership on licence by committee and can be revoked by the committee.
6. Insured as member to sail at the club and in club boats.
7. Club Toppers available for rental
8. Parent or guardian to be responsible for preparing child for sailing to the slip, including preparation of sailing attire, bouyancy aid etc and be available at all times during participation and be there to receive child after sailing.
9. The Committee will rely on the parent or guardian to have made a judgement on the day as to the willingness and competency of their child to go sailing; (considering the varying degrees of conditions.)
10. Parent or guardian to sign a form accepting rules of membership on behalf of child and be responsible for implementing them (Child Policy to be attached).
11. Parent or guardian to notify cadet parent or OOD on duty of their child's participation.
12. On duty cadet parent to notify rescue.
13. Cadets must sign out going on to the water and sign in on return or use the relevant tagging system.
14. Cadets are subject to rule for minors regarding club hours.
15. Cadets are not allowed to use any club facility without parent or guardian on the club premises
16. Use of dining room only with parent for sailing suppers.

**It is assumed that when a parent/guardian signs an application for membership as a Junior Cadet that they agree to the above conditions.**
